



Year 1 home learning support – Week beginning 30th March Theme: Easter

<p style="text-align: center;">Phonics</p> <p>Choose a story you like. Ask your child to spot different sounds (phonemes) in the story. Pick some from the sound mats in your pack. Can you hunt for the Year 1 common exception words?</p> <p>Play some phonics games using your new Phonics Hero login.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Writing</p> <p>Can the children make/draw Easter cards and then write them with a hello message to post off to family and friends? <u>Challenge:</u> Can the children write a little story to go in the card?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>Can the children go on a shape hunt? Can they find 3 D solid shapes? Cube, cylinder, sphere, pyramid or cuboid. Can they find 2D flat shapes? Triangle, square, circle and rectangle. Look up on the internet any shapes that you can't name.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>Anything counts – the on line books e.g. Starfall or Oxford Owl, street signs, comics, instructions, jokes on yogurts, recipes etc</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>Can the children find out what material is the most absorbent? (Soaks up liquid.) Make a little spill of water on the table – try different materials to mop it up. E.g. fabric, foil, a wooden spoon, a piece of plastic or a piece of kitchen roll!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PE</p> <p>Try the Joe Wicks daily PE lessons live on You Tube at 9.00 each morning! Or try some of the Boogie Beebies dances.</p> <p>Try moving like different spring animals around the room e.g. a chicken, a lamb or a rabbit.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Art and DT</p> <p>Look out of the window – can your child sketch a particular tree, house or plant?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>Can you have a go at playing some old games together?</p> <p>Marbles Hopscotch Hide and Seek What's the time Mr Wolf?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">RE</p> <p>Can you complete anymore of the 40 Acts of Kindness? https://content.scriptureunion.org.uk/index.php/40-acts-schools</p> <p>If you have a Bible read the Christian story of Easter or watch an animated version on You Tube.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>Make a video or take photos of how you celebrate Easter in your family.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Music</p> <p>Choose some songs to sing together – pick family favourites. You could join in with the Gareth Malone Great British Sing Along. https://decca.com/greatbritishhomechorus/.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p>We have learnt about the countries and capitals of the United Kingdom. Can the children remember them? (England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. London, Edinburgh, Cardiff and Belfast.) What can you find out about the capital cities?</p>
