

Keeping Children Safe from Algorithms

• Online sites such as YouTube use **algorithms** (computer programming) to recommend videos to watch based on your viewing habits

• Research has shown that these algorithms can push users towards increasingly extreme content

• Far-right and 'incel' content is also easily accessible on sites such as Reddit, Instagram, TikTok, Discord and Twitch

• Be **mindful** of what pupils are doing online

Encourage **critical thinking** when faced with targeted adverts and algorithms

There are 12 weeks in the year that children are off please book your holiday during this time.


