

If your child has borrowed any of our clothing, please may we ask that you return it cleaned. If you have any school uniform you no longer use please drop it in to the office.



Your child can still come to school with any of the following:


- -Phlegmy cough, -Phlegm (snotty mucus in nose or mouth)




