This could be:

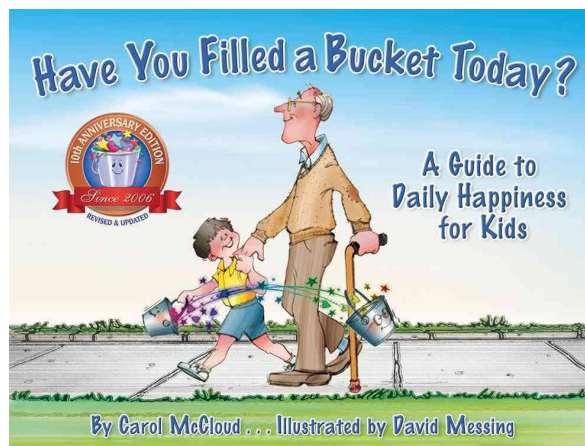
