

## **SAFEGUARDING CORNER**

This week we wanted to let you know that we will be having a special week next week to talk to the children more about bullying. We will launch the week by having an "Odd Socks" day on Monday when the children can wear odd socks to school to remind us that differences are good!



We will talk to the children about what bullying means the repetitive, intentional hurting of one person or group by another person or group, where the relationship involves an imbalance of power. Bullying can be physical, verbal or psychological. It can happen face-to-face or online.

We will also talk to the children about the importance of telling a trusted adult if they are being bullied and also if they notice someone else being bullied.
