



Topic: People Who Help Us

In this topic we will be learning about ourselves, our families, and who can help us in our school community. We will then learn about people who can help us in our local community such as the police, fire service, nurses, doctors, vets, bin men and others.

Just Like Me!



- In maths we will be learning to recognise the numbers and quantities 0-5 through mental recall and using pictures to support. We will be learning which pairs of numbers make a number for example $1 + 1$ makes 2, $3 = 1 + 2$.
- In whole class reading we will be exploring and listening to stories linked to our topic. We will be learning our sounds in Read Write Inc to help us with our reading and writing and we will be learning to write our names and write letter shapes.



- During our topic time we will be exploring homes, different families, feelings, how to listen, people who help us and what they do, wear and use. We will explore through our discovery play how to use all the different areas in our classroom and do our own learning in each of them, from building homes to role-playing in the Creator's home as well as doing creative singing, dancing, paintings, collages and models!

- We will be starting P.E. this term, learning how to get dressed and undressed for P.E. and will be exploring coordination and balancing in our lessons. We will also be developing our muscles and fitness in discovery time by riding the bikes and using large equipment.

Home Learning



Reading: Each week your child can choose a library book to take home and share with you then swap it for another one. There will also be a Read Write Inc sound book with a reading diary coming home for you and your child to practise the sounds they are learning. Please record in the reading diary when you have read together. When you have read 5 times a week your child will receive a prize from the prize box.



Maths: Soon your child will come home with Doodle maths login and then on Fridays there will be online maths learning set for your child to complete at home.



Creative: You can choose from one of these ideas:

- Choose your favourite people who help us and create either a drawing, painting, collage or model using toys of your favourite person who helps. When you have done this, you can either take a photo and post it on Dojo to share with the class or bring it into school to share.
- Find out some facts about people who help us and tell us in a video, then post this on Dojo.

Important weekly day reminders:

- **Monday- Library day and reading diary check day.** Your child can change their library book if they have brought back the previous one. We will also be checking the diaries to see who has read **5 times** and gets a prize!
- **Friday- P.E. day,** please bring your child's P.E. kit every Monday.
- **Friday – Show and Tell** – your child can bring in something from home that they would like to share with the rest of the class. This needs to be something that fits in their bag, we do not have the space to store the things they bring in. Please talk to them about it so they can confidently share in front of the class.
